CI Engaged in the Development of China-CEEC Education Exchange Portal



Under the leadership of Global Engagement Office, and after three months' preparation, the first group of video Mandarin classes produced by UNNC CI for *China-CEEC Education Exchange Portal* was about to complete by the end of May. The class contained two modules twenty lectures focusing on beginning level Business Chinese. CI Mandarin teachers and 11 outstanding Chinese and international students participated in the class producing.

The development of *China-CEEC Education Exchange Portal* was one of the key programs of Ningbo Municipal Education Bureau's 'Fourteenth Five Year Plan'. Besides Chinese language courses, the website would also contain various courses on Chinese culture and vocational skills from different universities and schools in Ningbo. The website would be officially launched on the 7th China-CEEC Expo & International Consumer Goods Fair. Through the perspective of educational exchange, it aimed to present the image of Ningbo city to people from Center and Eastern European Countries as well as other countries worldwide.

Besides GEO and CI, some more departments would join in the development of the website including Center for Research on Sino-British Universities and Language Center.
