Closing Ceremony of the 10th Ningbo International Students Festival and 2023 Ningbo International Students Chinese Speaking Competition



24th Nov, the Closing Ceremony of the 10th Ningbo International University Students Festival and 2023 Ningbo International Students Chinese Speaking Competition were successfully held at the University of Nottingham Ningbo China (UNNC).



16 foreign candidates from 12 countries gathered at the DH Lawrence Auditorium for the Chinese speaking competition. The final includes a thematic speech and a Chinese knowledge quiz covering basic aspects of Chinese history, geography, literature, and social customs.

Meiling Villar Lam, a Spanish student from NUBS China participated in the final round of the competition and got excellent prize in the event. The event attracted over 150 international audiences from universities and colleges in Ningbo city.
