Program Overview

New York City is the largest city in all of the United States and an iconic hub of culture, business, and international organizations. The city has gone by many names such as the City That Never Sleeps, The City of Dreams, and The Big Apple. Whatever you call it there is no denying it has an energy all of its own. New York City is also home to renowned international organizations such as the United Nations Headquarters.

Washington, DC is the capital of the United States and home to many important government organizations and representatives from countries all over the world. It is conveniently located just a three-hour train ride south of New York City. Washington, DC serves as the headquarters of major international organizations such as the World Bank and International Monetary Fund.

Our program is organized into a series of lectures and organizations visits in both New York City and Washington, DC. Local faculty considered leading experts in their field will give lectures to complement visits to some of the most influential international organizations in the world. The program is designed to give future leaders a head start in the international organization's arena, our program offers classroom-based learning about the history and future of these organizations as well as guided visits to the headquarters of important offices in New York City and Washington, DC. Students attending this program should be excited about first-hand experiential learning and eager to understand the complex inner workings of international organizations.

Program Strengths

New York City and Washington, D.C. are both hubs for international organizations and offer participants a breadth of opportunities for learning on this topic.

A mix of three experts will offer lectures with experience working in strategic positions within major International Organizations and conducting research in the field:



Dr. Thomas Weiss, Presidential Professor, The City University of New York, Graduate Center. Dr Weiss is internationally recognized as a leading expert on the UN. He has written extensively about international organizations and global governance including ten books he is the sole author of, the coauthor or editor of more than 40 other books, and more than 250 articles and book chapters. He has held leadership positions and professional posts in academic research institutions and in prominent non-governmental organizations and think tanks.

Dr. Bruce Jenks, Adjust Professor of International and Public Affairs, Columbia University School of International and Public Affairs. Dr. Jenks has served in various roles within the UN system including Assistant Secretary General at the United Nations Development Program. He continues to remain actively engaged with UN reform initiatives. In addition to teaching at Columbia, he serves at the senior advisor at the Dag Hammarskjöld Foundation.

Vikram Nehru, Distinguished Practitioner-in-Residence, John Hopkins University School of Advance International Studies. Vikram Nehru has served as the Director of the Economic Policy and Debt Department and the lead economics on China among various other roles during his tenure at the World Bank. His research focuses on economic, political and strategic issues confronting Asia. Vikram Nehru's work has been published in numerous journals, books, and op-eds.

The mix of academic and practical experience will provide a balanced look at how these organizations are influenced and operate.

2020 年暑期 SAF-纽约-华盛顿国际组织项目 报名通知

依据我国政府鼓励支持大学生到国际组织交流、参访及实习任职政策导向,秉承 SAF 通过海外交流学习提升学生就业竞争力的宗旨,SAF 通过 SAF 在纽约的 SAF-IES Abroad 学习中心,为广大中国学生量身定制了 2020 年 SAF-纽约-华盛顿国际组织主题学术项目。该项目通过讲座、案例分析和实地参访对国际组织的历史、机制及运行进行了全面的阐述,使学生对于国际组织有第一手的了解和认知,为以后申请在国际组织的实习及就职打下坚实的基础。现将项目通知如下:

一、 项目优势

- **系统性介绍国际组织的运作**:项目从国际组织的历史、运行机制、其在多边国际政治中的作用等方面全方位的了解国际组织的运作现状、未来和其机制,从而使学生了解世界上主要国际组织(如联合国、联合国开发计划署等)的主要任务,了解这些国际组织的日常运作,并拓展学生对国际事务和国际关系的视野和认识。
- 实地参访在纽约和首都华盛顿的国际组织:纽约和华盛顿是众多国际组织,政府机构和世界各国代表处所在地,项目期间 SAF 会安排学生到各大国际组织进行实地参访并参与访谈对话,如联合国总部、国际货币基金组织,联合国开发计划署、世界银行等。学生们通过一系列见习参访活动,进一步获得对于国际组织的感性认知,了解国际组织角色和使命以及日常运作,获得第一手的信息。多个国际组织为 SAF 学生独家定制参访内容,部分国际组织机构仅对 SAF 学生开放,不向公众开放。
- **资深国际组织专家授课:SAF**请到了重要的国际组织中担任战略职位·专攻研究国际组织领域的多位专家为学生授课。
- **参与纽约的社会文化活动:**项目期间住在纽约曼哈顿中心,博物馆,大剧院咫尺之遥,零距离感受全球金融中心包罗万象的文化带来的震撼。
- **学生服务完善**: SAF 将从咨询、申请、行前、接待、健康安保、应急支持等各个方面为学生们 提供全方位的服务。同学们还将受到 SAF-IES Abroad 纽约中心现地团队(包括中心主任、学 术负责人、实习协调员、学生事务协调员等)的全方位现场支持和服务。
- 提供项目证书:项目结束后,学生将获得 SAF 颁发的项目结业证书。

二、项目详情

1. 项目时长: 2020年8月4日-2020年8月17日(两周)

2. 项目内容:详细介绍国际组织的系统和机制,通过介绍国际组织的历史、其在多边国际政治中



的作用、国际组织的力量和有效性以及未来国际组织的发展给予学生系统性、全局性对于国际组织的了解。通过特别安排的参访机构所提供的讲座、学生可以详细了解该国际组织的角色以及运行机制,从而进一步从微观层面具体了解国际组织的运行。项目还将覆盖国际金融组织的特别内容。
