UCLA

The University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) is one of 10-campus University of California system, including UC Berkeley, UC San Diego, UC Santa Barbara, and others. UCLA is a top-ranked research university and offers bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees in a wide variety of fields. Located in one of the safest and most attractive parts of Los Angeles near Bel Air, Beverly Hills, and the Pacific Ocean. UCLA has a beautiful, park-like campus and outstanding sports and recreation facilities.



UCLA ranks 15th in The *Times Higher Education* World Reputation Rankings (2025). The reputation survey was completed by more than 10,000 senior academics from 138 countries. Times Higher Education has a separate World University Ranking. In the latest edition (2026), UCLA is 18th in the world and number 2 among U.S. public universities. UCLA ranks 16th in the Academic Ranking of World Universities (2025) by Shanghai Ranking Consultancy based on faculty publications and citations and the number of alumni and faculty who have won major awards. The world ranking relies on performance indicators in the areas of teaching, research citations, industry income and international outlook, U.S. News & World Report ranked UCLA 13th (2025-2026) among global universities.

Los Angeles

Located on the Pacific Coast in the southern part of the state, Los Angeles (L.A.) is the largest city in California. The warm, sunny year-round climate is ideal for outdoor sports and recreation, including swimming, surfing, golf, tennis, hiking, and many other activities. L.A. is a city of contrasts with beautiful beaches, mountains, desert landscapes, the hustle and bustle of business districts and freeways, and the small-town feel of peaceful neighborhoods and quiet streets. Well-known for Hollywood and the film industry, L.A. is also a hub for international business, fashion, design, and culture, especially for a wide variety of museums, concert halls, and live theater. L.A. is also a starting point for sightseeing and excursions to San Diego, Santa Barbara, Las Vegas, and the Grand Canyon.

● **Academic Courses**

Choose from UCLA undergraduate courses in more than 1,000 subjects, including arts, engineering, film and TV, management, political science and more. Most UCLA Summer courses offer four units of credit, but some may offer two, three or five units as well. International students are required to enroll in a minimum of eight units per session, which means two or three courses.

● **Course Prerequisites**

Some UCLA Summer Sessions courses have prerequisites that are indicated in the course description. Please make sure that you have experience comparable to the listed course prerequisites; there is no need to submit school transcripts.

● **Grade Reports & Transcripts**

Students are issued an official UCLA transcript upon completion. All grades earned in Summer Sessions become part of your official UCLA transcript, which shows all course work completed at UCLA.



Admission Requirements

- Copy of passport
- Scores of TOEFL iBT 80 or IELTS 6.5, or DUOLINGO 105, or the equivalent (For UNNC students, the English Proficiency Requirements could be waived)
- University transcript with a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4-point scale or the equivalent
- List of courses the student wants to take
- Financial certification
- **Requires F-1 visa**
