Summer Programme Introduction

Global Engagement Office recognizes the importance of studying abroad to broaden students' academic experience and intellectual horizons as well as benefit students' future career development.

For the year 2025, we have selected around 20 summer school programmes offered by UNNC partner universities around the world. For 2 to 8 weeks during summer, students will have a taste of what it's like to study at some of the best universities around the globe and interact with students coming from different backgrounds. Moreover, the relatively short period and flexible curriculum allow students to arrange schedule that best suits their needs and develop knowledge of a foreign living environment and teaching methods.



FASStrack ASIA: The Summer School 2025, National University of Singapore

Programme dates: 1-19 July

A 3-weeks summer programme based in NUS UTown, FASStrack taps into NUS research strengths in the region and offers Asia-themed courses across disciplines to enrich students' knowledge and understanding of various regional topics and issues. Students get to attend classes held in a dynamic and multi-cultural learning environment with both NUS and international students. Some of these courses feature local fieldtrips to facilitate experiential learning outside the classroom. In addition, students have opportunities to explore and learn more about Singapore's culture and heritage through social events. Courses offered include The Rise and Fall of Great Cities, Principles of Visual Communication Design, The Evolution of a Global City State, Introduction to Psychology, Emotions and Social Life, and more.

LMH Summer Programmes, Lady Margaret Hall, the University of Oxford

A typical LMH Summer Programmes lasts for six weeks and consists of two course options, though students may choose to study one course lasting three weeks, or select three courses and join for nine weeks. Students can choose to take courses in the same subject area, or select courses from different disciplines to create a personalised programme. LMH Summer Programmes include a lecture series plus small-group study seminars and 'tutorials', highly personalised classes for two to four students which are central to the teaching methods of the University of Oxford.

Credential Programmes, The University of Chicago Harris School of Public Policy

The Credential Programs available in 2025 Summer include:

• <u>Data and Policy Summer Scholar Program (DPSS)</u> (30 June – 15 August, online)
This program is designed to develop robust data analytical skills with an emphasis on policy impact. Open to participants of all levels, it covers key subjects such as Data Analytics and R Programming. Learners will also engage in policy research projects alongside UChicago faculty, with a total commitment of 10-15 hours per week.

Policy Research and Innovation Bootcamp (PRIB) (28 July – 8 August, in-person)

PRIB is a two-week, in-person program, encompassing rigorous training in policy research methods, hands-on projects addressing real-world policy challenges, and unique opportunities for career exploration and leadership development, with a commitment of 30-40 hours per week.

International Summer School, University of California, Los Angeles, USA

Programme introduction: Choose from UCLA undergraduate courses in more than 1,000 subjects, including arts, engineering, film and TV, management, political science and more. International students are required to enroll in a minimum of eight units, which means two or three courses. Students may order an official UCLA transcript upon completion. Students also enjoy an extensive array of campus resources, including libraries and athletic facilities, as well as cultural events that are among the world's finest.

Programme dates: June 23 – August 1, 2025 (Session A)
August 4 – September 12, 2025 (Session C)

Fees: \$8650 for homestay housing or \$9150-\$9950 for Residence Hall housing, Including Application fee, Campus Fee, Registration fee, 8 Units fee (\$385/unit), Pre-arrival online orientation fee, Housing (Homestay with 14 meals per week, or Residence Hall with 15 meals per week), Health Insurance, Airport pickup, Visa counseling, and Management fee.

Application for tuition waived places

Some of UNNC's partner universities accept summer school students under the existing exchange agreement, the nominated UNNC students don't need to pay tuition for attending summer school. However, students should be prepared to cover their living expenses, air tickets, insurance, etc by themselves during summer school.

The following five universities are offering tuition-waived places:

- Radboud University Summer School: 6 places
- Aarhus University Summer School: 12 places
- Technical University of Denmark Summer School: 6 places
- University of Hohenheim Summer School: 4 places
- Kühne Logistics University Summer School: 3 places

Undergraduate degree students in Year 1 whose average mark of the autumn semester of 202425 is 65 or more, or Y2 and Y3 students whose average mark of 202425 is 60 or more are eligible to apply for the tuition waived places. As most summer programmes require academic background, Y2 and Y3 students' applications will be preferred.

If you want to apply for the tuition-waived place for a certain programme, please download the application form from the summer school website (https://www.nottingham.edu.cn/en/global/summer-programme/overseas-summer-programme.aspx) and send application documents to International-summer-school@nottingham.edu.cn by the deadline 28 February.

All applicants will be notified of the nomination result by email around the mid of March.



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can summer school credits be transferred back to UNNC?

No. Summer School credits are not accepted toward degrees at UNNC.

2. Does UNNC offer any scholarship to students attending overseas summer programme?

No scholarship is available, however, students can apply for tuition-waived place for attending certain summer programme if it suits your interest.

3. Does UNNC student need to provide English test certificate for attending summer programme?

No. As you are taught in English at UNNC, no English test certificate is required for the application. If necessary, you can apply for a letter from the Hub that explicitly states the course is taught in English at UNNC.
