

2022 University of California, San Diego Summer University Program

Founded as an experiment in 1960, UC San Diego is driving change far beyond our walls to advance society and propel economic growth.

UC San Diego's main campus is located near the Pacific Ocean on approximately 1,200 acres of coastal woodland in La Jolla, California. UC San Diego's rich academic portfolio includes seven undergraduate colleges, six academic divisions and six graduate and professional schools.

UC San Diego is making waves in the rankings. Globally and nationally, our campus is recognized for improving social mobility, offering a high-quality education at an affordable price, producing powerful research, advancing health care and more.

In 2020 for the fourth year in a row, Times Higher Education ranked UC San Diego 1st among the world's top "Golden Age" universities—the best higher education institutions that were founded between 1945 and 1966.

In the 2021 Academic Ranking of World Universities released by the Shanghai Ranking Consultancy, UC San Diego was ranked the 14th best university in the nation and 18th in the world. The campus was also ranked 3rd best public university in the U.S.

UC San Diego's Biological Sciences, Bioengineering and Scripps Oceanography are ranked 1st in the nation according to the results of the 2010 National Research Council Data-Based Assessment of Research-Doctorate Programs, conducted every ten years.

UC San Diego received \$1.54 billion in sponsored research funding for FY2021 (July 1-June 30). This marks the 12th consecutive year the campus has earned more than \$1 billion in funding to support its extensive research enterprise.
